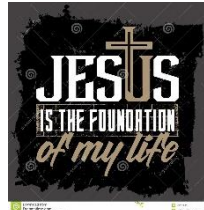

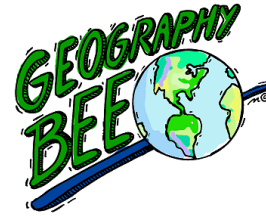
Teacher workday JWP will be in session

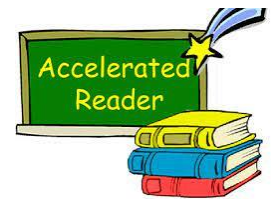
