

Over 350 items were brought in for Project Community Connect out of Mankato. Because of your generosity we are able to share these items with those who are less fortunate. Thank you!!




2018 Accelerated Reader Challenge Final Standings


Congratulation to our students in grades 1-8 for placing 8th out of 54 schools participating in the National Challenge. Outstanding! They read books worth an average total of 35.24 points per student, exceeding last year's accomplishment of placing 13th with an average 27.43 points.

Here are the average points per student in each class and their standing compared to other classes of the same grade:

1 st	13.9	17 th	5 th	53.00	5 th
2 nd	18.55	20 th	6 th	17.50	26 th
3 rd	26.50	16 th	7 th	71.52	3 rd
4 th	56.70	1 st	8 th	29.80	12 th



Happy Pi Day! 3.14 (March 14th) was another successful Pi Day in the middle school. Students in 6th grade calculated how to get Pi by dividing the circumference by the diameter, did a Pi Day scavenger hunt on the internet finding answers to a variety of questions, and had a Pi recitation contest. 7 & 8th grade also watched a few Pi Day videos and recited digits of Pi. Our top Pi memorizer was Christian Born with 26 digits memorized! 6-8th grade also ended the day singing some Pi day songs such as "Ludolph the Mathematician" and "Pi Day Time" sang to the tunes of "Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer" and "Silver Bells." 
