April Chapel Offerings - Heifer International

This organization sends children to school in 3rd world countries and provides families with medicine, clean water, food, and animals. Heifer believes that ending poverty begins with agriculture. The mission of Heifer International is to end hunger and poverty while caring for the Earth. Heifer does this by providing appropriate livestock, training and related services to small-scale farmers and communities worldwide. They work with Cambodia, Ecuador, Ghana, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, India and Kenya.



In April, we will focus in collecting for **Irrigation Pumps and Garden Seeds. Our goal will be to take in \$600.** This will pay for 2 Irrigation Pumps (\$150 each) and 5 Bundles of Garden Seeds (\$50 each). Having clean water and food are essential for people to survive.

- Use the App to scan store receipts containing box tops items

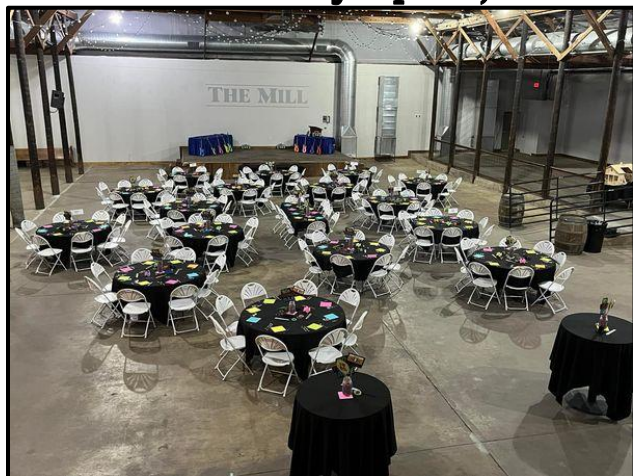
- Assign the earnings to the Trinity class of your choice
