


Each student in grades 5-8 is working on an individual

#### Ukrainian Refugees find refuge in Romania

"Our God, our Help in ages past, Our Hope for years to come, Our Shelter from the stormy blast, and our eternal home."



Here are some of the Ukrainian refugees just after their arrival in Romania. In the lower left corner is Sergiu Trifa, our Romanian helper. Sergiu has helped

hundreds of refugees across the Ukrainian-Romanian border. He has gotten them food, water, shelter, medicine, if needed, as well as prayers and devotions in Ukrainian.

This first group included the family members of a couple Ukrainian Lutheran pastors from southern Ukraine. In a

note to one of these Lutheran pastors, still in Ukraine, Sergiu wrote, "Pastor Timerkan, it is almost 4 AM here and they have arrived



and are in a safe place! God is good and merciful! They are all in a place with heat and food and the needs they have! We are going to take good care of them! God bless you!"

Here's Pastor Timerkan's reply on Thu, Mar 3, 2022, at 10:55 PM. "About meeting. My wife was impressed at how nice Romania greeted our people. You are so kind! Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! You are God's merciful hand for our people today. I will be thankful to you and your country and people who helped to organize if for the rest of my life."
