Box Tops for Education Competition

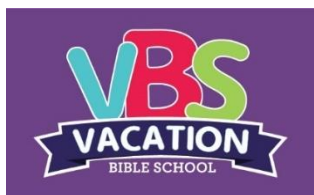
Total box tops scanned for April:

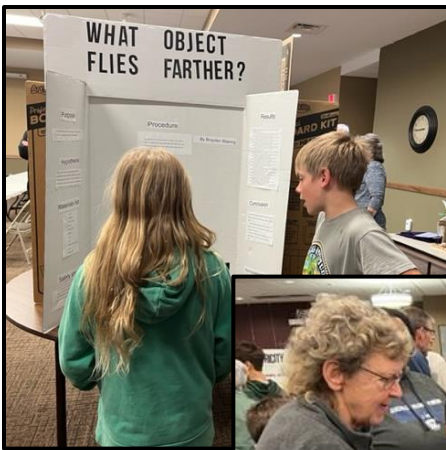
Mankato Store Receipts. Please

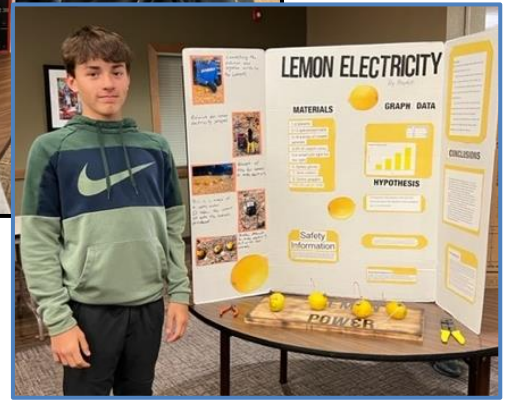
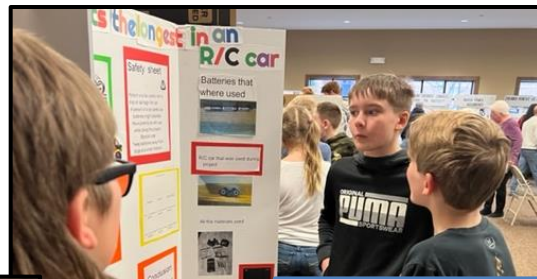
