September Chapel Offerings will be for Central Lutheran School in Newhall, IA, which was damaged on August 10, 2020, when a storm of unprecedented strength with 90+ mph winds and a tremendous amount of rain went through. The school sustained a massive amount of damage to the exterior and interior of the building. In addition to the extensive exterior damage there is a tremendous amount of water and storm damage inside the building; the small gym, the kitchen, the computer lab, the classrooms, and specifically the 2nd Grade classroom which was damaged by the falling roof. Their need is great as they begin a school year like never before due to COVID-19; this natural disaster adds another burden on their teachers and staff, board members and families, all of whom are dealing with the destruction of their own personal homes and farms.

Their theme this year is **Go Forward in Faith**. They ask for prayers as they go forward and donations to help rebuild and replace items destroyed in the storm. Bring your dollars to chapel to help this school rebuild so they can continue with their mission to prepare "our children to be disciples in this life, and for the life to come."
