**Coriolis** 6th and 8th graders in Earth Science discovered how the Coriolis affect makes wind move in different directions around the Earth. In this picture students are demonstrating how the wind (yellow ball) moves when the Earth (merry-go-round) spins.



The Coriolis effect is the apparent acceleration of a moving body on or near the Earth as a result of the Earth's rotation. The Coriolis effect is an important determinant of wind direction on a global scale.

Anything that flies (planes, birds, missiles, space rockets) is affected by the Coriolis effect. For example, a plane that flies along a North-South path must not fly directly towards the target location.
