What are cells? & What are cells made of?

Our 7th grade students learned about all the different organelles in cells and what makes a cell. This included creating a 3D representation of a plant or animal cell. They had a list of organelles they had to include in their creation. They also had to write down each of the organelles and their function. Such as the Nucleus is the brain of the cell and controls the functions of the cells. The Mitochondria are the energy factory of the cell and takes in materials to create into energy for the cell to use. Though cells are small, together they form tissues that themselves form organs, and eventually entire organisms.


