I have been reading a book someone gave me at Christmas by Max Lucado which is titled, "you'll get through this". 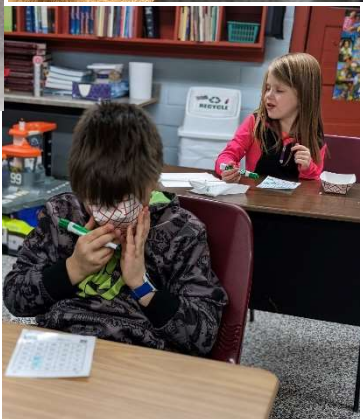
- A few people to oversee the auction. Records from past auctions will help guide you.
