This year's Fire Prevention Week campaign was, "Learn the SOUNDS of Fire Safety." Is there a beep or a chirp coming out of your smoke or carbon monoxide alarm? What does it mean? Knowing the difference can save you, your home and your family! Make sure everyone in the home understands their sounds and knows how to respond.

### Hear a BEEP, Get on your Feet!

Get out and stay out! Call 9-1-1 from outside.

Hear a CHIRP, Make a Change! A chirping alarm needs attention. Replace the batteries or the entire unit if it is over 10 years old.

#### Keep safe with a home escape plan:

- Working smoke alarms on every level of the home, in every bedroom, and near all sleeping areas
- Two ways out of every room, usually a door and a window, with a clear path to an outside meeting place (like a tree, light pole or mailbox) that's a safe distance from the home
- Practice day and nighttime home fire drills by all members of the home, at least twice a year

**TO QUALIFY**: children and adolescents under 20 years old, who are covered by State Insurance: Minnesota Health Care Plans (MHCP) such as MA, South Country Health Alliance, Blue Plus, UCare, or uninsured. Patients participating in our program who are enrolled in a state assistance program will have their services billed to insurance and the unpaid portion will be paid by grant funding. If patient is uninsured, Let's Smile, Inc. utilizes grant/donation funding to cover the cost of their services.
