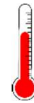

Patients participating in our program who are enrolled in a state assistance program will have their services billed to insurance and the unpaid portion will be paid by grant funding. If patient is uninsured, Let's Smile, Inc. utilizes grant/donation funding to cover the cost of their services.
