September Chapel Offerings Summary

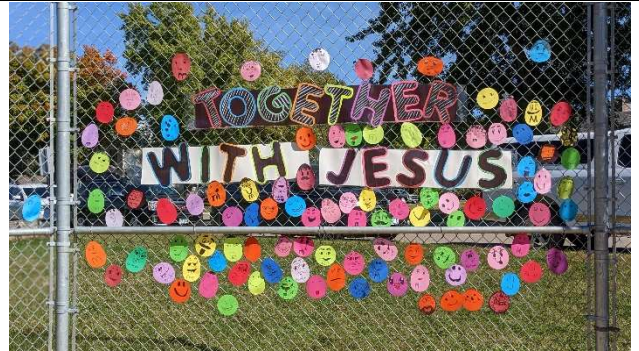

ABOUT DROP OFF BEFORE SCHOOL
