

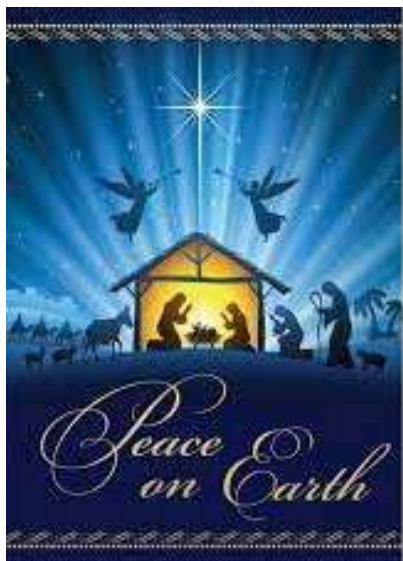

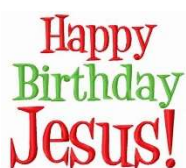

Thank you to PTL for providing funds for the parties.

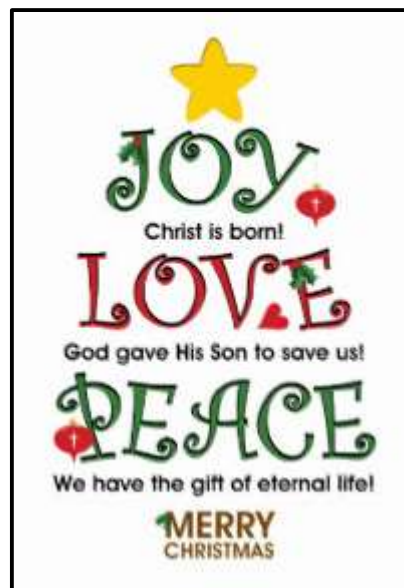
