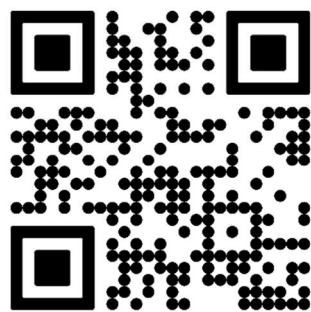

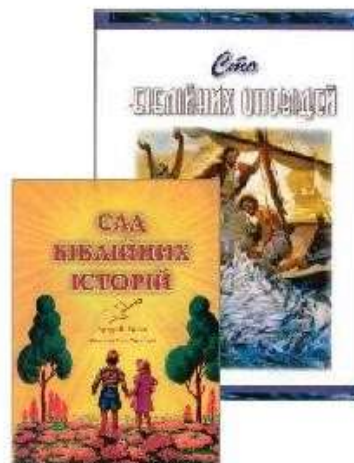
**On February 24, 2022, Ukrainians' lives changed overnight.**
