14th Annual Fun Run Fundraiser Sept 23, 12:45-2:45


At last Friday's Kickoff, all students were given an informational letter and sponsor sheet. Be sure to gather your pledges from friends and family!

NWEA Measures of Academic

Progress® (MAP®) Testing will take place on and off from September 12-23 for grades K-8. Please be sure your children have healthy breakfasts and adequate sleep. A pep talk about not rushing and reading through the guestions carefully would also be appreciated!

MAP Testing presents students with engaging, ageappropriate content. As a student responds to questions, the test responds to the student, adjusting up or down in difficulty. As students answer a question correctly, they get a question of higher difficulty. If the students do not correctly answer the question, the next question will be a little lower in difficulty. Through this process, we will get a better idea of what the student knows. This results in a rewarding experience for the student, and a wealth of detailed information for teachers, parents, and administrators.
